

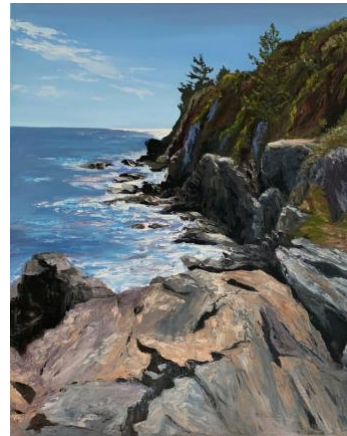

Daniel Lake, "At the Regatta", The Louise Pittaway Fine Art Awards, Excellence in Painting.

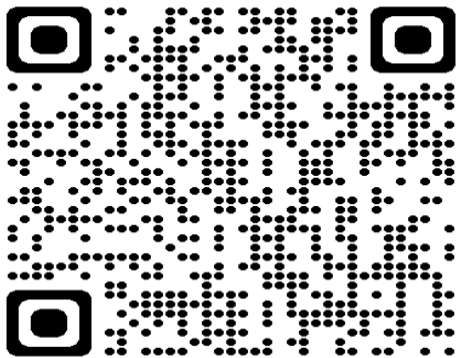


Web sites and QR codes

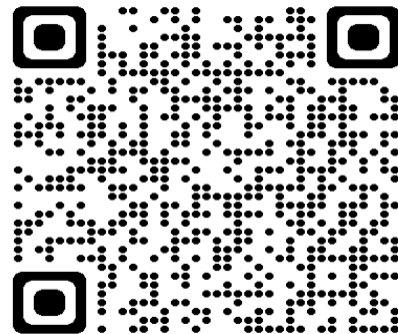
Do you have a website already built on the Internet?
