Open to all East Greenwich Art Club Artist Members in good standing (Dues Paid)

Entry Fee: \$15 for first piece, \$10 for second piece

Up to 2 pieces will be accepted from each member. Wall space is limited so picture sizes are a consideration: one should be no larger than 16x20, the other smaller.

Your picture must be framed with wire, ready to hang. No sawtooth hangers.

Unframed, gallery wrapped canvas must be a minimum of 1 1/2" deep

Note that the EGAC commission is 10% on sales.

Delivery is on Saturday June 1st from 10 AM – 12:00 PM.

Reception on Thursday June 6th from 6:00-7:30 PM. Food and Drink contributions gratefully accepted!

Pick up art on Saturday morning June 29th between 10 AM and 2 PM.
